





Why should we use AgriCure CALF BOOST?

1. What is AgriCure CALF BOOST?

AgriCure CALF BOOST is an oral paste, helping to support growth, immunity and health in young calves. CALF BOOST is a micro nutrient paste formulated specifically for new born calves and young calves at times of stress, to support:

- Activity
- Appetite
- The emerging immune system
- Growth rates
- Boost recovery

2. What are some of the benefits you may see from using AgriCure CALF BOOST?

When using AgriCure CALF BOOST, you may see:

- Increased appetite in the new born calf; when fed immediately after birth CALF BOOST helps to stimulate appetite in the calf ensuring good colostrum intake.
- Increased activity in the new born calf; when fed immediately after birth CALF BOOST
 will help to boost the calf's activity in the first few hours of life, helping it to get up
 and suck quicker, gaining the needed colostrum.
- A healthier calf.

3. What does AgriCure CALF BOOST contain?

AgriCure CALF BOOST is formulated from a high concentration of:

- Omega 3
- Prebiotic
- Vitamins (B1, B2, B6, B12, E, D3 and A)
- Trace elements

4. When should AgriCure CALF BOOST be fed?

AgriCure CALF BOOST should be fed as a full 30ml paste:

- · Immediately after birth to any new born calf
- 5 days after birth (if necessary to give further boost)
- Bought in calves when they first arrive in the yard
- To calves recovering from diarrhoea

Active ingredients in CALF BOOST

Active Ingredient	Function
Vitamins B1, B2, B6, B12	Used to help regulate body temperature in new born calves.
Omega 3	Supplementing Omega-3 fatty acids has shown to assist in decreasing the inflammatory response and may improve the survival of septicemic calves.
Prebiotic	Shown that it may assist in decreasing the incidence of gastro-intestinal disease.
Garlic	Excellent appetite stimulant.
Rosemary & Oregano	Natural anti-inflammatory and anti-oxidant properties.
Seaweed Extract	Helps to stimulate immunity and gut response.
Glucose	Energy source for calves, which is essential in first few hours.

Feeding Instructions:

Feed 30ml to the back of tongue as soon as possible after birth. If required repeat feed after 5 days to weaker calves. Can also be fed to calves recovering from diarrhoea.

Storage Conditions:Keep out of the reach of children. For oral animal use only. DO NOT FEED TO SHEEP Storage Conditions: Store in original container below 25°C. Keep out of direct sunlight. Do not freeze.
